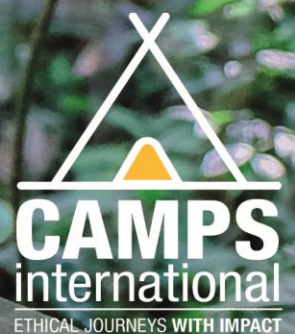


Discover Borneo



Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive

The team arrive in Kota Kinabalu and transfer to one of our community camps (approx. 3hrs). After being welcomed by our Camps staff, the team will settle into their accommodation and receive a full safety and orientation briefing before a walking tour of the local community and project sites. After dinner, there is an opportunity to join in with traditional local dancing.

Day 2: Cultural Day

Today will be filled with interactive sessions on learning traditional ways of local life from cooking and handicraft lessons to visiting the local communities to see how they live. There will also be the opportunity to play sports such as football or volleyball with the local children. Return to camp for dinner and reflect on the days' activities.

Day 3 & 4: Community Project Work

The next two days will be spent on vital, sustainable project work based on the needs of the local community at the time of travel. There will also be the opportunity to interact, teach English and play games with the local children.

Day 5: Sepilok Orangutan Sanctuary

Today, the group will visit the world famous Sepilok Orangutan Sanctuary, where orphaned Orangutans are taken in, cared for and rehabilitated back into the wild. Just next door is the Sunbear Conservation Centre, so students will also get the opportunity to see the endangered Bornean Sunbear. The group will stay in a hotel in Sepilok tonight as they will be awake early to transfer to the airport for an internal flight.

Day 6: Fireflies Eco-Camp

After an early breakfast, the team will catch a 1hr internal flight from Sandakan to Kota Kinabalu and then transfer to Fireflies Eco-Camp which is located on the Klias River. Look for wildlife including the famous Proboscis monkey whilst on a river cruise before returning to camp for dinner. Once it's dark, the team will be taken to see the amazing fireflies display along the river.

Day 7: Utan Paradise Jungle Camp

Transfer to Utan Paradise, settle into accommodation and have lunch. The team will learn traditional jungle skills that locals have used for hundreds of years including making traditional traps and building shelter before going on a short

trek through the jungle. Dinner will be back at camp, before enjoying an insect observation session.

Day 8: Departure

Transfer to Kota Kinabalu Airport for the team's departure flight home.
