Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Kilimanjaro Airport and transfer to Moshi (Accommodation – Camp Mbokomu, 7 nights)

Kilimanjaro Airport is located less than an hours drive from the town of Moshi and Camp Mbokomu. The team will be shown their tented camp as well as being provided with a safety briefing and an orientation of the area. The rest of the day is left for students to settle in and enjoy the view of the spectacular Mt Kilimanjaro.

Day 2: Chugga caves and waterfall trek

The group will be introduced to the history of the chugga tribe and be informed of the importance of the caves before exploring them for themselves. After a picnic lunch, the group will go for a short trek down Marangu waterfall to take in the incredible scenery.

Day 3-5: School Project

It is just a short walk from camp to Mbokomu school where the team will be given a briefing on daily school life and an overview of the ongoing projects. These three days will be spent working on some of the necessary projects at one of the local schools within the community of the camp. The school infrastructure is dilapidated, therefore, projects will be related to improving the infrastructure, such as classrooms, toilets blocks, or soil erosion. The group will have the opportunity to play games and sing songs with the local children during their time at the school.

Day 6: Cultural day

The team will be able to submerge themselves in to rural village life and learn about the local community's day to day activities. There will be an opportunity for them to participate in such activities as preparing corn, banana harvesting and a cooking demonstration. The afternoon will be spent with a project handover to the local school before a football match with the undefeated local school children!

Day 7: Safari to Arusha National Park

Arusha National Park is located less than 2 hours drive away from camp and the team departs early from camp following the saddle of Kilimanjaro to Mount Meru. Arusha National Park

is one of the most beautiful National Parks in Africa and is home to abundance of wildlife including leopard and hyena. The group will have an opportunity to shop for souvenirs after an exciting day at the park before heading back to camp.

Day 8: Departure

Departure timings will vary. Late departures will allow for a short shopping trip in Arusha.
