



## GRADE 9-10 EQUIPMENT LIST – 2018/19

The following equipment requirements will be needed on the first day of school. During the first week of school, students will be shown how to best organize their equipment for each subject.

### **General Stationery**

A pencil case  
Pens (blue, black and red)  
Pencils (at least 2)  
Colored pencils  
Eraser and sharpener  
Stapler and staples  
Glue stick  
Highlighters (2 colors)  
Protractor and Compass  
Ruler  
Plastic protector sleeves (sufficient supply for each subject)  
A4 Loose leaf lined paper – hole punched (sufficient supply for each subject)  
Journals/notebooks (must be A4 size)

**Band/Choir** – Required materials to be discussed first week of classes

**Art** - Visual Art Diary (available at school store)

**Drama** - Required materials to be discussed first week of classes

**New Media Studies (Grade 9)** - DSLR Camera and Laptop (as per prerequisite)

**Science**           -1 binder and 1 small notebook (available at school store)  
                          -Calculator (Physical Science – grade 9)  
                          -Calculator (Physics, Biology, Chemistry – grade 10)

**Computers/ Programming and Robotics** – 1 flash drive

**Math** – 1 Lever arch binder (thick enough to keep notes from entire year)  
          1 Thin binder (thick enough to keep notes of current unit + notepad)  
          1 Set of 10 colored file dividers  
          2 Notepads of A4 lined paper (hole punched)  
          1 Pad of A4 5mm square paper (hole punched)  
          1 Geometry set (protractor, compass, set square etc.)  
          1 TI-Nspire graphic calculator (available at school store)  
          2 Whiteboard markers and 1 mini whiteboard eraser

**Social Studies subjects** - 1 binder with plastic protector sleeves and colored dividers

**French/Spanish**       - 1 2-hole binder with colored dividers and plastic protector sleeves  
                              - 1 small/pocket Spanish-English or French-English dictionary (no electronic translators)  
                              - Pencils and 1 Pen. (blue or black ink)

**Arabic/AFL** – 1 binder and 1 school issued notebook, 1 Arabic/English dictionary for AFL only (available at the school store)

**Sports Science and PE** - school issued PE shorts/pants, school issued PE shirt, running shoes, water bottle, binder/notebook for Health

**ELL** – 1 Paperback student dictionary or an electronic translator

### **Textbooks**

In many subjects, teachers will supply handouts and work booklets in which students write notes and use for study and revision. Where textbooks are issued, students will borrow these from the library and return these at the end of the year. If books are damaged, parents will be charged for their replacement.

**Student Planners** – are NOT compulsory for all students but are available from the school store in September at a cost of 25dhs each. Grade 9 & 10 students will be using their MacBook and our Homeroom program will include using their devices for academic organization.
