



GRADE 11-12 EQUIPMENT LIST - 2017/18

The following equipment requirements will be needed on the first day of school. During the first week of school, students will be shown how to best organize their equipment for each subject.

General Stationery

- A pencil case
- Pens (blue, black and red)
- Pencils (at least 2)
- Colored pencils
- Eraser and sharpener
- Glue stick
- Highlighters (2 colors)
- Ruler
- Plastic protector sleeves (sufficient supply for each subject)
- A4 Loose leaf lined paper - hole punched (sufficient supply for each subject)
- Journals/notebooks (must be A4 size)

Music - Good quality over the ear headphones (not ear buds), laptop preferred, all other required materials to be discussed first week of classes

Art - Visual Art Diary (available at school store), A3 sized, spiral bound

Theatre - Notebook (available at school store), A4 sized

Sciences - 1 binder, 1 lab notebook (available at school store), calculator

Computers/ITGS - flash drive or cloud storage.

Math - 1 Lever arch binder (Thick enough to keep notes from entire year)

1 Thin binder (Thick enough to keep notes of current unit + notepad)

1 Set of 10 colored file dividers

2 Notepads of A4 lined paper (hole punched)

1 Pad of A4 5mm square paper (hole punched)

1 Geometry set (protractor, compass, set square etc.)

1 TI-Nspire graphic calculator (Available at school store)

2 Whiteboard markers

1 mini whiteboard eraser

Social Studies subjects - 1 binder and colored dividers

French/Spanish - 1 binder with colored dividers

- 1 small/pocket Spanish-English or French-English dictionary (no electronic translators)

Arabic - 1 binder and 1 notebook (available from school store)

TOK - 1 binder

PE - school issued PE shorts/pants, school issued PE shirt, running shoes, water bottle

English - While all texts studied are available for checkout from the library, if students wish to annotate texts - which is recommended - they should purchase their own copies.

11 SL - *Death of a Salesman* by Miller and *A Doll's House* by Ibsen;

11 HL - *A Doll's House*, *Othello* by Shakespeare (NOT *No Fear Shakespeare*), and *1984* by Orwell.

12 SL - *I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings* by Angelou;

12 HL - *I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings* by Angelou and *Karnak Café* by Mahfouz

Textbooks

In many subjects, teachers will supply handouts and work booklets in which students write notes and use for study and revision. Where textbooks are issued, students will borrow these from the library and return them at the end of the year. If books are damaged or lost, parents will be charged for their replacement. In some subjects, students will have the option to buy their textbooks so that annotation can be done.
