WHAT IS THE IB PRIMARY YEARS PROGRAMME?

The IB Primary Years Programme (PYP) for children aged 3 - 12 nurtures and develops young students as caring, active participants in a lifelong journey of learning.

Through its inquiry based, transdisciplinary framework, the PYP challenges students to think for themselves and take responsibility for their learning as they explore local and global issues and opportunities in APPLY NOW! real-life contexts.

INQUIRY: THE UNIVERSAL AMERICAN WAY

As a PYP school, student learning at Universal American School is organized through the PYP units of inquiry using comprehensive, researchbased curriculum aligned to the philosophy of the PYP. Our Early Years program features exploration and discovery as a way of learning, enabling children to develop confidence, creativity, and lifelong critical-thinking skills.

The units of inquiry are studies that span several weeks and are in-depth, project-based investigations of concepts that are part of your child's everyday life. They feature topics like music making, buildings, insects, imagination, and communities. Children raise questions about the concepts and find answers by exploring, experimenting, and investigating with a hands-on approach through activities that take place in our indoors and outdoors learning spaces and beyond.






LEARNING OBJECTIVES
